



VOLUNTEER FISH WARDEN(S) OPEN POSITION FOR HARRIS PARK METRO DISTRICT

Harris Park needs volunteer Fish Warden(S) for 2019-2020 season.

Duties include:

- Patrolling lakes daily and enforcing the Harris Park Rules and Regulations
- Reporting violations to the Harris Park Board of Directors
- Assistance with Harris Park Fish Supplier in the delivery and stocking of fish.

Fish warden will be required to:

- Sign a volunteer waiver agreement.
- Attend monthly board meetings (April through October) and provide any updates to the community and the board of directors.
- Have knowledge of Rules and Regulations of the Harris Park Metro District, Colorado Department of Wildlife and the State of Colorado. (Printouts will be provided).
- Carry fish warden supplies in his/her vehicle at all time during these months. Supplies are provided by Harris Park Metro District on a loan basis.

Fish Warden will receive:

- An annual fishing badge at no charge.
- Mileage reimbursement upon submission of a monthly mileage expense report to the Bookkeeper.
