It could be a leak in the piping under the ground or we have people who are not signing in/out what they are getting. We also don't know how much is being used by the community center. I am going to see if Nov. is different

on the read. I can't find anything for the key lock system. We can switch the keypad system, but I can't find anything that has a meter attached to it. I do think the keyless system is a better plan. It will prevent key loss and we can solve the problem of people who do not pay their dues, but use the system still.

- 4. Chris what does the community think?
 - a) Jimmy and (Chris): we are only limited on the users. Part of the issue is that keys get lost, but we have no idea if someone finds them and is using them. I did find something that records how many gallons are used every five minutes. (You don't think we need to limit how much water someone can use?).
 - b) Adriana and (Chris): isn't it a little unethical to put a limit on the well? It is open to the public. Is people's usage an issue? (Yes. there was 1500 gal over last month.)
 - c) Jimmy: There are two meters in the well house to separate the community center and the hydrant.
 - d) Steve: As far as the hydrant goes, I agree with Jimmy. We cannot have more than 25 people using the hydrant. The amount used isn't the issue. One option is to start charging a fee for usage. That will help to regulate the usage.
 - e) Monique: we could call a meeting with the people using the well and let them know what is happening and the changes we are having to do in order to accommodate.
 - f) Connie: This is a community well. I think they should pay for it.
 - g) Steve: I think the people who have access to the water, they should pay for it.
 - h) Gene: It doesn't make sense to me that we have to pay for the upkeep of this well, when we can't even use it.
 - i) Beth and (Mercedes): We will have to have the service plan reviewed/revised. There are more people living here now than when the well was put in. We should also look at the bylaws. We could hold a community event that we bring in water to help too if needed. (I think we should bring the people using the water into a meeting and talk with them first before changing the service plan).
 - j) Chris and (Mercedes): would we need a special meeting? (We could do a work session to discuss. We will also send out an email to the key holders about this upcoming discussion.)
 - k) Monique: I think either way we know something needs to change, so we could start talking now. Then we can come up with a gameplan from there.
